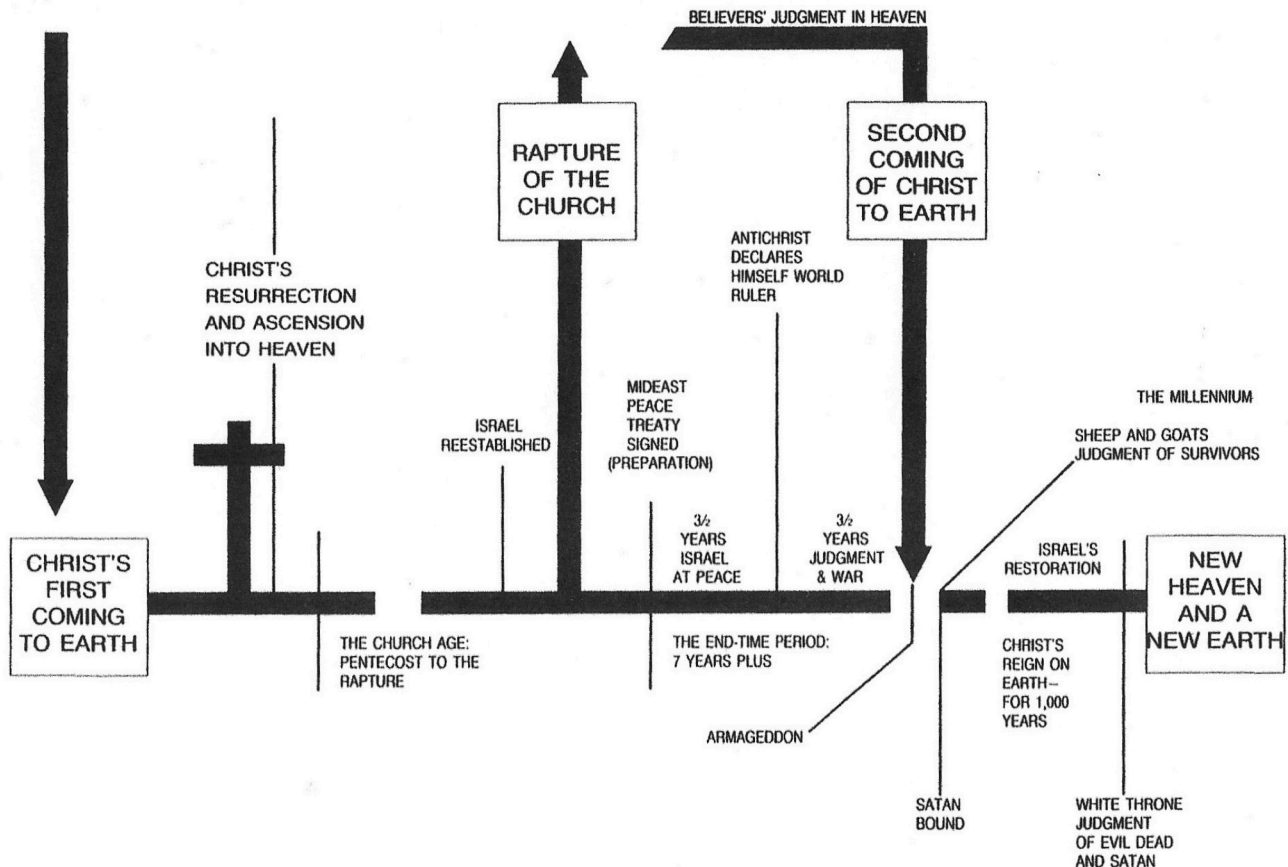

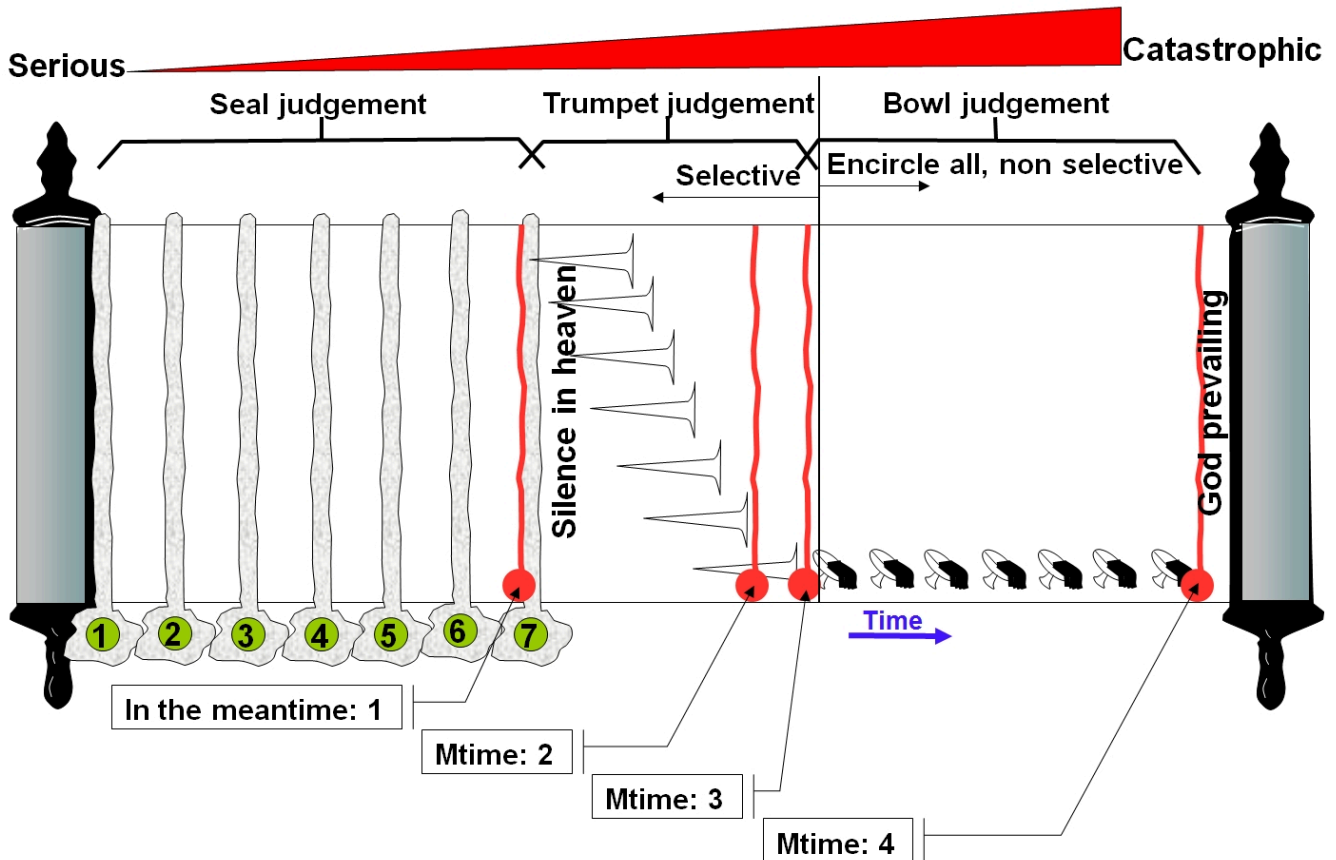


Revelation 4:1 "Come up here"
